TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY



The judges shall reserve the right not to issue an Award in any category. High Commendations can also be awarded;

The judges reserve the right to establish if an entry has been entered in the correct category;

The judges reserve the right to transfer an entry into the category they deem appropriate or not to accept any entry;

The judges reserve the right to amalgamate categories if the number of entries is deemed insufficient; or split categories if deemed necessary;

The entrants must obtain permission and the owner's cooperation regarding access for judging;

Judging will commence on 1 July 2024 and will continue until 31 July 2024. The time and date of judging will be advised by email;

Judges must have internal access to the building at the time notified for judging; It is the responsibility of the entrant to ensure that the required safety equipment is available to the judges i.e. ladders, vests, helmets etc;

Past residential, commercial and civil project nominations cannot be re-entered into the EBC Awards (irrespective of the previous outcome);

To enter the EBC Awards, the relevant online nomination process must be completed for each entry;

In order to qualify for an award, all outstanding membership fees must be paid in full. No awards will be issued to non-financial members All material (including photographs and videos) submitted with an entry become the property of Master Builders. It is therefore recommended that all entrants keep a copy of their complete entry;

Any material supplied with an entry may be reproduced in media releases, publications, web sites and other promotional material at the discretion of Master Builders. The entrant indemnifies Master Builders against any claims in respect of copyright. - Upload a detailed PDF submission of your scope of works on the project that addresses the judging criteria. Please provide concise, relevant and technical information about the project;
- Upload a copy of the project occupancy permit or "notice of completion" from Head Contractor/ Defence
- Upload a copy of the contract price section of your contract;
- Upload a completed Client Declaration Form;
- Upload a list of major subcontractors and suppliers used on this project;
- Upload photos available, including written consent from Defence (an email is sufficient) noting it has been approved. If you are unable to provide written consent, we are able to accept a photo of the overall project (1 is sufficient) from the Defence Image Gallery.

CFI CONTRACTOR ENQUIRIES CHECKLIST

Background

Estate and Infrastructure Group (E&IG) contractors are required to seek Defence review of products that are intended for public release and relate to their work with Defence. Products that must be submitted to Defence under this process include:

- media releases
- social media posts
- website content
- project profiles
- presentations
- posters
- images taken by contractors on-base or of Defence personnel or equipment
- award nominations
- abstracts

Please note: This process applies to contractors on Capital Facilities and Infrastructure Branch projects. Previously cleared products that are proposed for use in a new context must also be reviewed under this process.

Checklist

Before submitting a request, contractors must complete and attach this checklist.

Yes N/A If images are taken from the Defence Image Gallery, an application for Defence copyright approval has been submitted using the Defence Image Gallery web-Χ form. The images must not be used until copyright approval is confirmed. If images were taken by the contractor on a Defence base or training area, proof Χ of permission to take images is attached to the request.
